Entry Requirements:

No formal qualifications necessary. Level 1 an advantage but not a necessity. Anyone who has already successfully completed the first two units can work towards the L2 Award in Art.

Course Structure & Content:

The course comprises of two units, the first is Mixed Media Painting. In this section participants will be encouraged to use and experiment with a range of materials, techniques and methods in both traditional and non traditional ways.

The second unit is an experimental approach to 3D work with an opportunity to use a range of found materials, objects

and ready - made to generate ideas for making sculpture.

Assessment:

Assessment activities range from group discussion to the production of artefacts. The course is very practical with a 'hands on' approach although a simple assessment booklet accompanies each unit. This is usually completed in class time following group discussion. A sketchbook or journal is also compiled alongside practical work to record development of ideas.
